

Vesper Psalms Grouped in Tones,

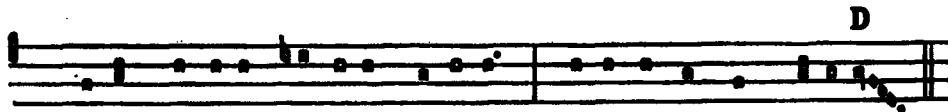
with the adaptation, by means of special types, of all cadences of the text to the different psalmodic clauses, mediant, and endings.

Psalm 109. *Dixit Dominus.*

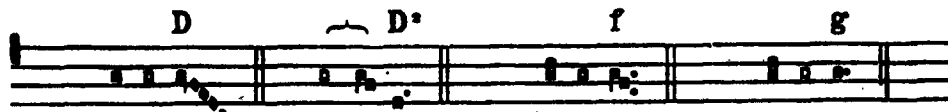
Tone 1. D, D, D², f, g, g², a, a², a³.

Mediant of 2 accents.

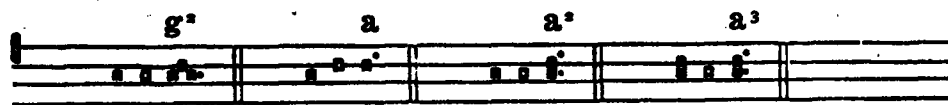
Endings of 1 accent with a preparatory syllable. (For the ending D², an extra note is added in anticipation of the accent in dactylic cadences.)
